

# Climate Change Action Strategies Project

## Guiding Questions

What are some economic, environmental, and social issues in the Pacific Northwest that have been impacted by global warming? What can we as students do about climate change here, now, and in the future?

## Your Task

You will be assigned to research an action that can be taken to solve problems that have arisen or will arise due to climate change. Your research will culminate in a presentation to the class about the action strategy and its effects.

You are telling the STORY of your action strategy. You will present your story to the class and it can take the form of a:

- PowerPoint presentation
- Movie
- Skit
- Song/Spoken word
- Podcast
- Comic strip/Animation

## What To Include

- Define the action: What is it? When people do this action, what kinds of things do they do?
- Current examples: What people or organizations are already doing this action to address the effects of climate change? (Start by researching local people/orgs, then move outward if none found locally.) What are they doing, or what have they accomplished already? Find at least 1 current example.
- Impact: How did or does this action help solve problems posed by climate change?
  - What is a specific issue (local or global) that the action strategy focused on?
  - Measurable or non-measurable effects
- What would it take to do this strategy?
  - Time
  - Cost
  - Limitations
  - Is this a strategy you or other students can do now? If not, what would it take for you to be work on this strategy in the future?
